CHOOSE THE RIGHT SUPPORT SURFACE

When it comes to the prevention and treatment of pressure ulcers, choosing the right support surface is key. According to Tag F-314, facilities should match a device's potential therapeutic benefit with a resident's specific needs. The effectiveness of a pressure redistribution device is based on its potential to address the individual resident's risk, the resident's response to the product and the characteristics and condition of the product.¹

There are two primary types of support surfaces1:

Static pressure redistribution devices are non-powered devices that may be indicated when a resident is at risk for pressure ulcer development or delayed healing. These devices include:

- Solid foam
- Gel-infused foam
- Convoluted foam (i.e., channel-cut or "egg crate" foam)
- Gel mattresses

Dynamic pressure reduction surfaces are powered devices that are indicated if a resident can't move into a variety of positions without placing weight on a pressure ulcer, if their weight completely compresses a static device that otherwise maintains its original integrity or if they have a pressure ulcer that is not healing as expected and it is determined that pressure could be contributing to the delay. Dynamic pressure reduction surfaces include:

- Alternating pressure mattresses and overlays
- Low air loss systems

When selecting a mattress, remember¹:

- Mattresses should be discarded if infectious agents, such as body fluids, have penetrated the mattress fabric
- Mattresses need to be properly sized to reduce the risk of entrapment, which can occur when a resident is caught between the mattress and bed rail
- According to Tag F-461, facilities must provide each resident with a clean, comfortable mattress

DO YOUR WHEELCHAIRS **MEASURE UP?**

Just as all residents are unique, not all wheelchairs are created equal. Although many nursing home residents rely on wheelchairs, they are often not assessed individually to ensure safe and effective mobility.

When selecting a wheelchair for an individual resident, be sure to take the following measurements into consideration. All measurements should be taken when the resident is sitting in a wheelchair or straight-backed chair.

Seat width: The goal is to distribute a person's weight over the widest possible surface. There should be clearance room on each side for ease of transfer and the individual should not rub against the side panels of the wheelchair.

Seat depth: The seat should be deep enough to distribute weight along the buttocks and thighs without creating undue pressure over the ischium or circulatory difficulties and skin irritation in popliteal areas.


Seat height: The seat height should allow the user to obtain optimal propulsion and prevent the person's knees from scraping the bottom of tables.

Leg length: The objective is to elevate the footplates to allow a 2" clearance above the ground. This makes it easy and safe to traverse curbs, doorways and uneven surfaces.

Arm height: The arms should be adjusted to help the user maintain correct posture and balance while simultaneously providing comfortable support for the arms and shoulders.

Back height: The back height should be selected based on an individual's physical needs and activity capabilities.

Oxygen Concentrator Care

Therapeutic use of medical-grade oxygen supplied via an oxygen concentrator requires trained clinical assessment, a prescription, in-servicing and instruction on the use, service, maintenance and support of the system you choose. We hope the following information will be useful to you in the creation of your own oxygen concentrator care plan.

Concentrator Care Checklist

Bacteria filter

Replace during preventive maintenance schedule

Exhaust muffler canister/exhaust muffler

- Perform the following at 20,000 hour intervals or as needed:
 - Replace muffler canister and muffler if plugged or restricted
 - Install new exhaust muffler if canister is in good condition

Exterior

Use EPA-approved cleansing and disinfecting wipes to keep ٠ the surface of the unit clean

Gross particle filter

These reusable filters can be blown clean or hand washed/ squeezed dry or replaced either weekly or as needed

Hydrophobic filter

- Replace the filter immediately if it becomes wet as it will prohibit or restrict the flow of oxygen
- Change the filter at ongoing intervals as detailed in your owner's manual

Alarm back-up battery

The battery (typically a 9-volt) should be changed annually or as needed

Filters and batteries

It is wise to keep at least one set of all replacement filters and batteries on hand

Maintenance log

We suggest keeping a maintenance log that notes the following about your concentrators:

- Unit's serial number
- Hours at time of service (from the digital hour meter)
- What maintenance was performed (i.e., changed battery, etc.)
- Date maintenance was performed
- Signature of person who performed maintenence •
- It is a good to keep a copy of this record on the unit

Note: Concentrator care and components will vary by manufacturer and brand. Please consult your owner's manual for specific guidance regarding your machines.
